Introduction

Market Overview

Most print solution vendors, resellers, and even printer OEMs often encourage customers to implement on-premises solutions. At face value, this seems innocent enough, but it can introduce excessive management, infrastructure costs, and overheads, as well as major security risks.

The global managed print services (MPS) market was valued at approximately USD 40.54 billion in 2024 and is expected to reach USD 53.37 billion by 2033, growing at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of about 3.1%¹. This growth is driven by the increasing need for cost reduction, better resource management, and environmental sustainability.

Problems with Current Solutions

We are told by Microsoft™ and other leading IT companies that the days of allowing IP connections from servers and/or user PCs directly to printers are a massive no-go in the modern IT environment. There are too many cataloged instances where this is proven to be bad practice in the modern IT landscape. A printer device is one of the most vulnerable entry points into a network, and exposing this risk with direct IP connections to PCs and services creates an easy route to exploit. In what other area of our architectures do we allow such massive addressing so openly?

So, why does everyone keep offering these methods and solutions? Because they don't have any other way in their portfolio and/or it's simply what they have always done. From a customer side of things, they trust that for something related to print, surely the printer manufacturer should know best. You would hope so, but look at the drive for the engagement: it's not the software that keeps the factories busy; it's the hardware. The hardware is where they make their money, not the software. This is why printer OEMs go into a customer opportunity with a handful of solutions to see what sticks; they don't actually mind what the customer chooses as long as they get the hardware contract.

Challenges with On-Premises Solutions:

Management Complexity: On-premises solutions require significant IT resources to manage and maintain the infrastructure, including print servers and delivery stations. This can lead to increased operational complexity and higher costs.

Infrastructure Costs: Implementing and maintaining on-premises print solutions involves substantial capital expenditure on hardware, software, and ongoing maintenance.

Security Risks: Security Risks: On-premises solutions can create vulnerabilities in a zero-trust environment, as they often rely on internal networks and servers that can be targeted by cyberattacks. In fact, 67% of organizations have experienced data losses due to unsecure printing practices². The average cost of a print-related data breach is over \$700,000 for US organizations³

ePRINTit doesn't need on-premises architecture or staff efforts and time to manage it.

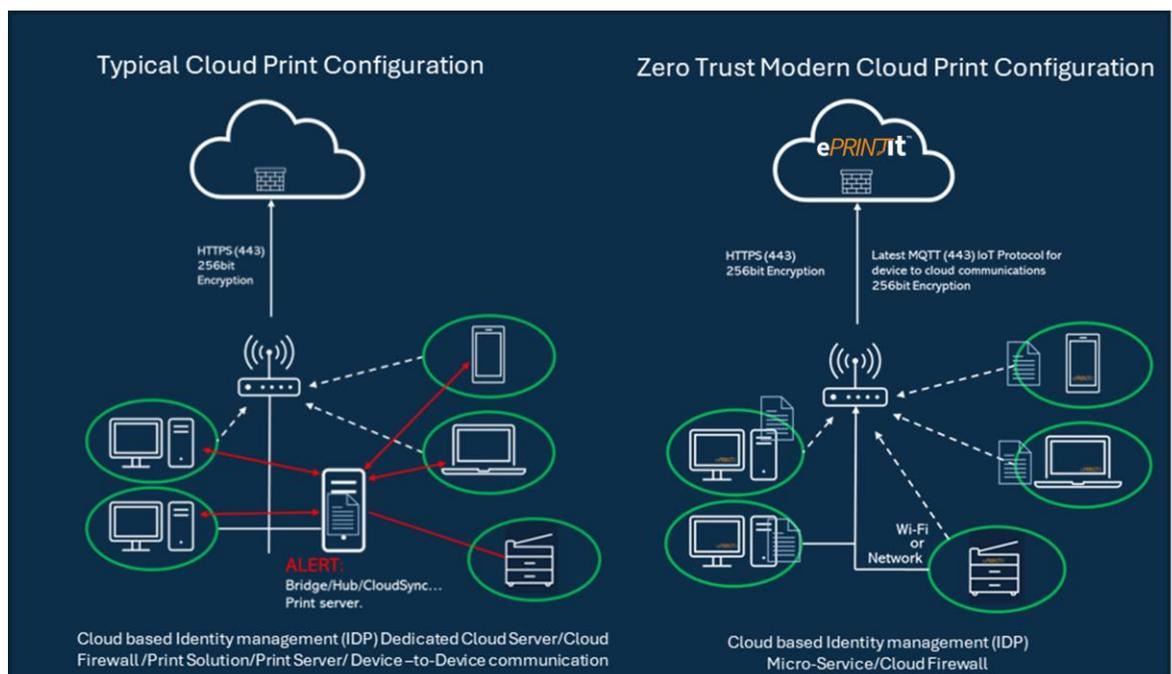
It doesn't need print servers and client PCs to connect directly with IP addresses to printers or print servers. It doesn't need any inbound

Don't chance security by letting hardware dictate that you should be using an archaic practice; it's 2025 where cloud IT rules and cyber threats are a very real thing!

The diagram below shows some of the weak points in print solutions where customers are left vulnerable behind hidden agents and internal or dedicated cloud servers playing a role behind a firewall, but completely vulnerable inside the network.

Bridging Networks – Your printers just need internet and power, and users can print to them regardless of what network they may or may not be on!

- ePRINTit has an applet that mimics a printer driver that creates an encrypted compressed PDF file – A technology enhanced and used by ePRINTit for over 15 years.
- No exaggerated latency from using Native printer drivers and sending huge spool files across the internet.
- Some technologies can only use native printer drivers but ePRINTit only works in encrypted compressed PDF files. These are consistently smaller than what normal printer drivers would create in RAW formats.

Quota's, profiling, full Multi SSO support within one cloud tenant.

- Other cloud technologies are limited by what they can do and often rely on either local servers or using the user's client PC to manage things. ePRINTit isn't limited by this.

Printer Devices do not have to be on the same network.

- Each device just needs internet and power, and you are done!
- They can all be completely isolated on their own vLAN talking to nothing but the internet router.

Users need power and internet to print.

- Users don't need to be on the same network as the printers.
- They don't even need to be on campus networks.
- Users print to the cloud.
- Users can be at home, in their dorm, at the cafe, at parents... They just print and then collect it from a printer when they get to campus, any printer!
